He spent his early years in the U.S. Navy, and upon receiving a medical discharge moved with his wife, Donna, to Sallisaw, OK and worked in Gore, OK at Sequoyah Fuels. Dan could often be found by his wife's side on shopping trips and was the best at picking out wonderful clothing and shoes for her. At 5:00 pm everyday Reba would start watching the door for her daddy to come home. From the immediate posts on Facebook you can be sure he was loved by all and will be missed beyond measure.
