February 25, 1923 - January 27, 2010

Beloved father and grandfather, Forrest Eldridge Pittard, 86, of Mableton GA, passed away on Wednesday, January 27, 2010. During his life, he served our country as a WWII Marine in the Pacific from 1942-1945. He also served as a firefighter for the city of Atlanta, coming to the aid of others until retiring many years later. A life-long Methodist, Forrest was a member of Bethany United Methodist Church in Smyrna and served his church in various capacities over the years. Among all of his other accomplishments, Forrest was a member of the Yaarab Shrine Temple in Atlanta, a Post Commander of the American Legion Post #156, and a member of Mableton Lodge #171. Forrest was able to touch the lives of so many people: friends, family, and his beloved wife, Falla, who was his one and only girlfriend of 65 years. Forrest was a loving, generous father, grandfather and friend, and a devoted husband who went to rest with his Falla who preceded him in death only 17 days earlier. Survivors include his daughter Terri Boyle and son-in-law Rick Boyle of Woodstock; grandchildren Jeff and Anna Boyle of Woodstock; great-granddaughter Ava Boyle; and brother Hal Pittard of Edgewater, Florida. The family will receive visitors at White Columns Funeral Chapel on Thursday, January 28, 2010 from 4:00-6:00 PM. A service will be held in Forrest's memory at Bethany United Methodist Church in Smyrna on Friday, January 29, 2010 at 1:00 PM with interment to follow at Mount Harmony Gardens.
