Biography Lois "Aunt Bit" McHelheney Musselwhite, age 92, of Mableton, passed away December 24, 2013. She was born in Atlanta, the daughter of Sara May Thomas McHelheney and Grover Cosmore McHelheney. Mrs. Musselwhite and her husband of 25 years, John Daniel Musselwhite travelled this country and Japan. After he retired as an army captain they ran a store and gas station in Smithville, NC. They also had a home in the Isle of Palms, Charleston, SC. Following his death in 1972 she returned to Mableton to live with her sisters, Dorothy Bell and Helen McHelheney.
