Reynauld Montego Thompson, age 43, of Powder Springs passed away Friday, January 23, 2015 at Wellstar Paulding Hospital in Hiram.

Reynauld Montego Thompson was born November 18, 1971 in Petersburg Virginia, where he attended public school and excelled in band. He lived in Petersburg until 1993.

Reynauld left Petersburg to attend DeVry Technology Institute in Atlanta Ga, in which he received a degree in Computer Technology.
